

Document Checklist – IEN Pathway (BC)

1. Two Notarized Government-Issued Identification Documents

Acceptable ID types are listed on our <u>website</u>.

Documents must be notarized by a notary public or lawyer (not a Justice of the Peace or Commissioner of Oaths).

• If your name differs across documents, submit a notarized proof of legal name change (e.g., marriage certificate).

If documents or notarizations are not in English, provide official English translations.

• IDs must be clear, legible copies. One must be a primary ID showing full name, date of birth, signature, and a recognizable photo.

🝞 2. Educational Credential Assessment (ECA)

Submit an ECA from one of the following approved agencies:

- World Education Services (WES)
- Comparative Education Service University of Toronto (CES)
- International Credential Assessment Service of Canada (ICAS)
- International Credential Evaluation Service (ICES)
- National Nursing Assessment Service (NNAS)

Note: If you submitted your ECA for IRCC and are applying to BC, Yukon, Nunavut, or the Northwest Territories, you may need a more detailed report. Check the agency's website for upgrade options.

3. English Language Proficiency (ELP)

You must provide valid proof of English proficiency. Accepted tests:

- CELBAN (Canadian English Language Benchmark Assessment for Nurses)
- IELTS Academic (International English Language Testing System)
- OET (Occupational English Test)
- PTE Academic (Pearson Test of English)

Test Score Validity:

- CELBAN: 3 years | IELTS, OET, PTE: 2 years
- Scores must be valid at the time of application submission.

Alternatively, you may provide proof of your English Language Proficiency by submitting any combination (at least two) of acceptable alternative documents listed on our website.

Note: Inspire may require an official ELP test if submitted alternatives do not meet requirements. Reminder: RN and LPN applicants share the same ELP requirements. HCA applicants must meet different ELP standards—see the official score chart.

4. Account Creation & Application Submission

- Create your Inspire account and submit your IEN application.
- Ensure all details are accurate and complete.
- Inaccurate or missing information may delay processing or affect eligibility.

Final Reminder: It is your responsibility to carefully review your application before submission.
